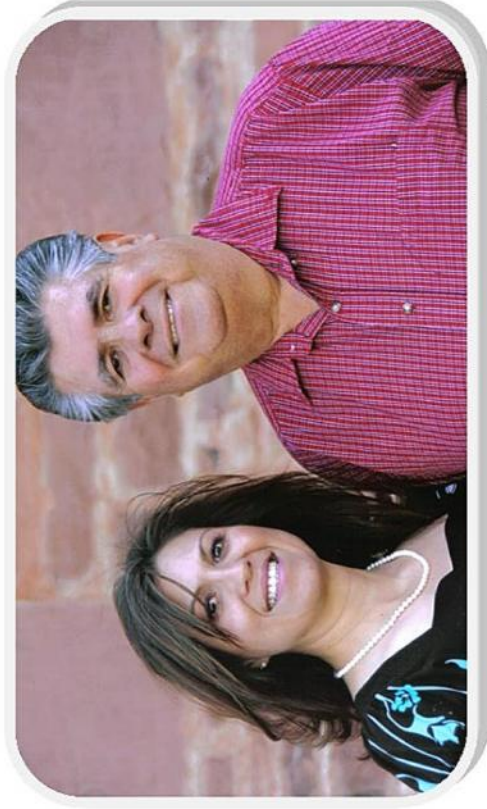


Andy Wilkinson
