“The Restoration of the Rio Mora”

Watrous, NM: The ecological balance needed to maintain natural habitats for both plant and wildlife is often at risk to a variety of factors, both manmade and natural. Everything from pollution, to overgrazing, and the occasional natural disaster can upset the structure of these habitats.

Throughout the 19th and 20th centuries these habitats along the Rio Mora would be forever changed by farmers, ranchers, and the U.S. Army.
