

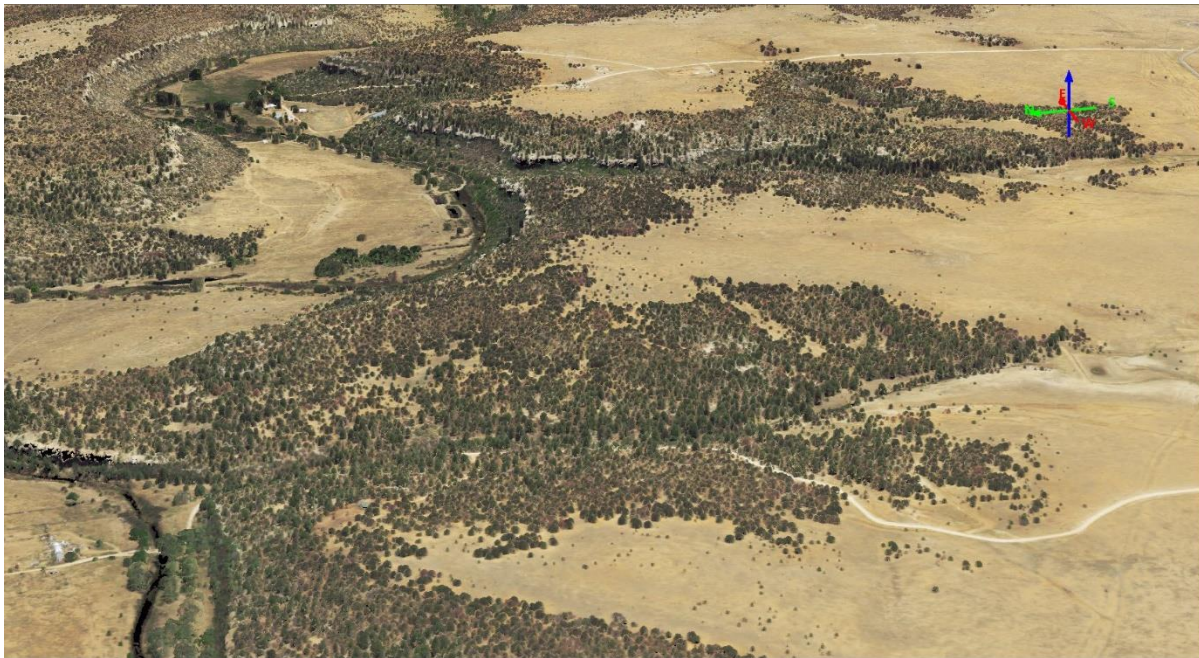
Rio Mora NWR Second Saturday Hike Series

Hike at Rio Mora NWR

Saturday, June 9, 2018

9 AM



Spring songbirds are calling, wildflowers are emerging. You can count on a naturally good time!

This is a rare opportunity to explore Rio Mora NWR, which is closed to the public.

Bring water, sunscreen, and snacks or lunch.

Meet at Loma Parda road (directions below) off the road at 9 am.

The hike is approximately 2.5 miles, easy to moderate in difficulty, with great wildlife viewing and photography opportunities.

Directions to Loma Parda Road:

From I-25, take exit 364 at Watrous, turn left on Highway 161, go under freeway overpass, continue west approximately 6.8 miles. The side road on the right is marked "Loma Parda."

From 518, take 161 east (right) at Buena Vista and go approximately 14.4 miles to Loma Parda Road on the left.

Turn onto Loma Parda Road for a short distance to park where a designated Friends Hike Leader and Debbie Pike, Visitor Services Manager, will be waiting for you.
