Launched in 2017, the First New Mexico Fiber Arts Crawl drew locals and visitors to studios and galleries in Taos, Espanola, Santa Fe and Albuquerque, honoring New Mexico's rich Fiber Arts heritage and contemporary culture.

In 2018, Mora joined the Crawl Map, and we began to consider the natural connection to Las Vegas, either returning home via I-25, or following the tour in reverse. After all, Las Vegas was the Wool Capital of the United States at one time, maybe even the World!

Planning for 2019, the Crawl organizers have promised to include Las Vegas, NM, if we can meet just a few requirements.

If approved as a thread, we will be on the Fiber Arts Crawl map, included in extensive marketing programs, and provided with postcards, posters, logos, etc. **Threads** are regions defined by a minimum of three approved "crawl" sites, which can be fiber-focused galleries, stores, farms, studios, museums etc.

Required:

- Apply as a site before February 15, 2019, Non-refundable fee of \$15.00. Full price due March 15, add'l \$60 Site, or \$160 Site +.
- Remain open all three days and hours of event.
- Studios and galleries must have at least 75% fiber arts during crawl.
- Collaborate with advertising and help distribute maps, passports, etc.
